
## IO2 TRAINING MODULES

The RISKREAL consortium has been hard at work in creating a Toolkit that included different theoretical modules, together with practical resources, aimed at supporting the building of psychosocial skills. These training modules have been developed to tackle the specific psychosocial learning needs that have been previously identified as critical by European employers and industry representatives, in order to make these tools of particular relevance within occupations where psychosocial occupational hazards related with emergency management are at a higher risk of occurring.

The Toolkit is intended to work hand in hand with Gamified Assessment App that was previously developed by the consortium to facilitate the appraisal of psychosocial skills, and the Virtual Reality Simulator that is currently being finalised. The training module addresses six dimensions, these being: Emotional soft skills, Interpersonal soft skills, Organisational soft skills, Personal soft skills, soft Thinking skills, together with Motivational Soft skills. Each dimension is equipped with various exercises, practical resources that include videos or tools, gamification techniques, a glossary aimed at familiarising novel readers with technical terms, together with a bibliography that directs the user towards further readings related to the skills

discussed.




# IO2 TRAINING MODULES

Soft skills are often discussed in relation to their meaningful contribution towards the workplace. They play a significant role in the achievement of results and success both at an individual and organisational level. What distinguishes this contribution from others is its relevance to low qualified workers at risk of psychosocial pressure or challenges.

The modules have been developed in close collaboration with industry representatives, psychology experts, employers, and human resource specialists in order to both inform the output's development and validate its relevance to actual needs faced within such working environments.

The toolkit is freely available from the project website and aims to be a beneficial resource to training companies, education services, NGOs devoted to inclusion, together with individuals that wish to improve their psychosocial skills for their current or prospective employment. This training kit is available in English, Spanish, Italian, Greek and Maltese.
